As part of its programs in Africa, funded by various donors including the Belgian Development Cooperation, Africalia builds partnerships with local organizations that carry out activities to achieve the above-mentioned objectives. Africalia occasionally grants support to projects beyond the accompaniment of the program's structural partners, depending on the available envelopes.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

- **Implementation period:** April to November 2021
- **Budget allocations:** 5.000 to 18.000 euros maximum
- **Presentation of your projects:**
 - Download the **presentation sheet** and send it back to africalia@africalia.be.
 - In your presentation, present your organization (its vision, activities, team, etc.) as well as the project(s) for which you are seeking support (objectives, activities, necessary resources, etc.). It is important to highlight: (1) the impact of your projects on the cultural sector as well as on your ecosystem; (2) your capabilities to carry out the project presented; (3) your motivations.
- **Principles and criteria for analysis:**
 - The aim of the presentation sheet is to establish a first contact in order to broaden Africalia's knowledge of the cultural actors in the countries in which the organization operates;
 - Africalia does not have its own funds, but operates through grants, for which it must comply with the rules and procedures. Depending on the funds available, Africalia may support a few one-off projects per year; however, there is no commitment or guaranteed amount;
 - Africalia will analyze the projects submitted and, depending on the budget available, will contact the organizations with which it would like to consider collaboration.

The deadline for submitting a proposal is: 19/03/2021!
